U110 Ivinson Road & Greenwood, Berwick Upon Tweed 20 MPH Speed Limit

Purpose of Report

This report sets out the background to the proposal to introduce a 20 MPH speed limit at the U110 Ivinson Road and Greenwood estate in Berwick-Upon-Tweed.

Recommendations

It is recommended that a 20 MPH speed limit at Ivinson Road and Greenwood is introduced as proposed.

Key Issues

The County Council has received concerns regarding traffic speeds at the residential estate of Ivinson Road and Greenwood in Berwick-Upon-Tweed.

The scheme is to be funded by Councillor Hunter through her Members' Local Improvement Scheme Allowance.

Background

The residential estate at Ivinson Road and Greenwood are both no through roads where the access adjoins with the B6435 Cornhill Road. Whilst street-lit and therefore denotes that a 30 MPH speed limit exists, the carriageways have no traffic calming features in place.

Concerns have been raised with the local County Councillor regarding vehicles speeding through the estate, which presents road safety issues for pedestrians, cyclists and those navigating through the route with the risk of collisions occurring.




Fig 1: Proposed 20 MPH speed limit extents at Ivinson Road and Greenwood

As a result, a 20 MPH speed limit is proposed to be introduced in order to alleviate these concerns and covers the full extents of lvinson Road and Greenwood, identified below in Figure 1. The measures will consist of new regulatory traffic signs along with road markings in the form of roundels, 'SLOW' text and new red surfacing at the access junction to denote the new speed limit.

Details of the proposals can be found in Appendix A. They are intended to increase road safety by reducing speed limits and to protect the amenity of the area overall. Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Orders.
