**Proposed Disc Zone Extension & Taxi Rank Removal – Bondgate Within, Alnwick**

### **Purpose of Report**

This report sets out the background to the proposal to remove an existing taxi rank and replace it with limited waiting disc zone parking at Bondgate Within in Alnwick.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the proposed parking restriction amendments are implemented in order to improve parking facilities in the area.

### **Link to Corporate Plan**

This report is relevant to the following key themes in the Corporate Plan for 2023-26:

‘Thriving Places and Culture – Neighbourhoods are safe, clean and well maintained’

### **Key Issues**

1. Northumberland County Council has received concerns regarding the current parking layout at Bondgate Within in Alnwick.
2. There is a lack of usage in the existing taxi rank, whereas visitor parking is in high demand in the town centre and allocated parking bays can often be at full capacity.

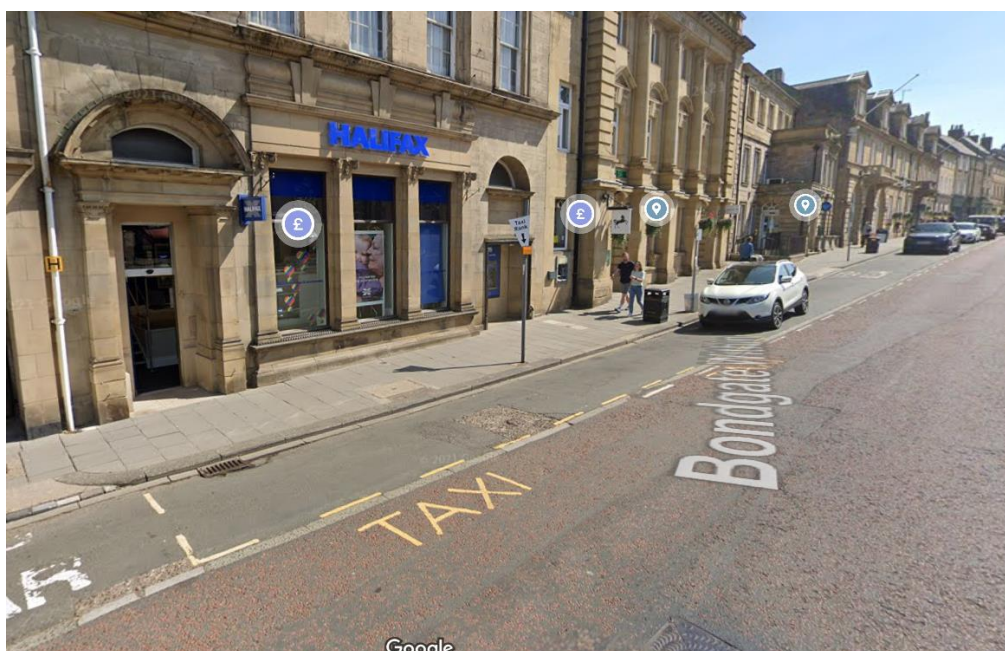

3. It is proposed to remove the existing taxi rank restrictions and replace the bay with an extension to the limited waiting disc zone parking restrictions in place at Bondgate Within.
4. The scheme is supported by both local County Councillors and Alwick Town Council.
5. The scheme is to be funded through the 2024/25 Local Transport Plan (LTP) programme.

### Background

Bondgate Within is situated within the town centre of Alwick surrounded mainly by commercial properties and is therefore a popular location for visitor parking. Marked parking bays are allocated on Bondgate Within and waiting restrictions in the form of double yellow lines are in place to prohibit obstructive and indiscriminate parking throughout the area, but the road is also included within Alwick's disc zone to permit limited waiting parking and is often at full capacity.

As well as disc zone parking, Bondgate Within has a taxi rank in place which prohibits any vehicle other than a licenced taxi from parking within the bay at any time.

The local County Councillors for Alwick and Alwick Town Council have raised concerns that the existing taxi rank is no longer utilised for its purpose and remains empty throughout the day. Given that the limited waiting disc zone parking bays are in high demand, a request has been made to replace this taxi rank with an extension of the disc zone.

A shared-use bay for disc zone parking on Monday-Saturday during the hours of 8am-6pm and a taxi rank between the hours of 6pm-8am every day were initially proposed and the extents of this can be found in Appendix A, however responses during the consultation advised that the majority of stakeholders would be comfortable with the rank being removed completely, as many licenced taxis use other facilities for the purposes of picking up and dropping off. Full consultation results are listed in Appendix B. As a result, the existing 'no stopping except taxis' restriction is proposed to be removed completely and the limited waiting bays as part of Alnwick's disc zone are to be extended to cover the extents of this taxi rank. Details of the proposed amendments which were re-consulted on with an overview of the final planned extents are outlined in Appendix C. No responses were received to the second consultation.

The proposal is intended to increase parking opportunities for visitors to Alnwick and residents and to protect the amenity of the area overall. Northumbria Police, directly affected properties, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Traffic Regulation Order.

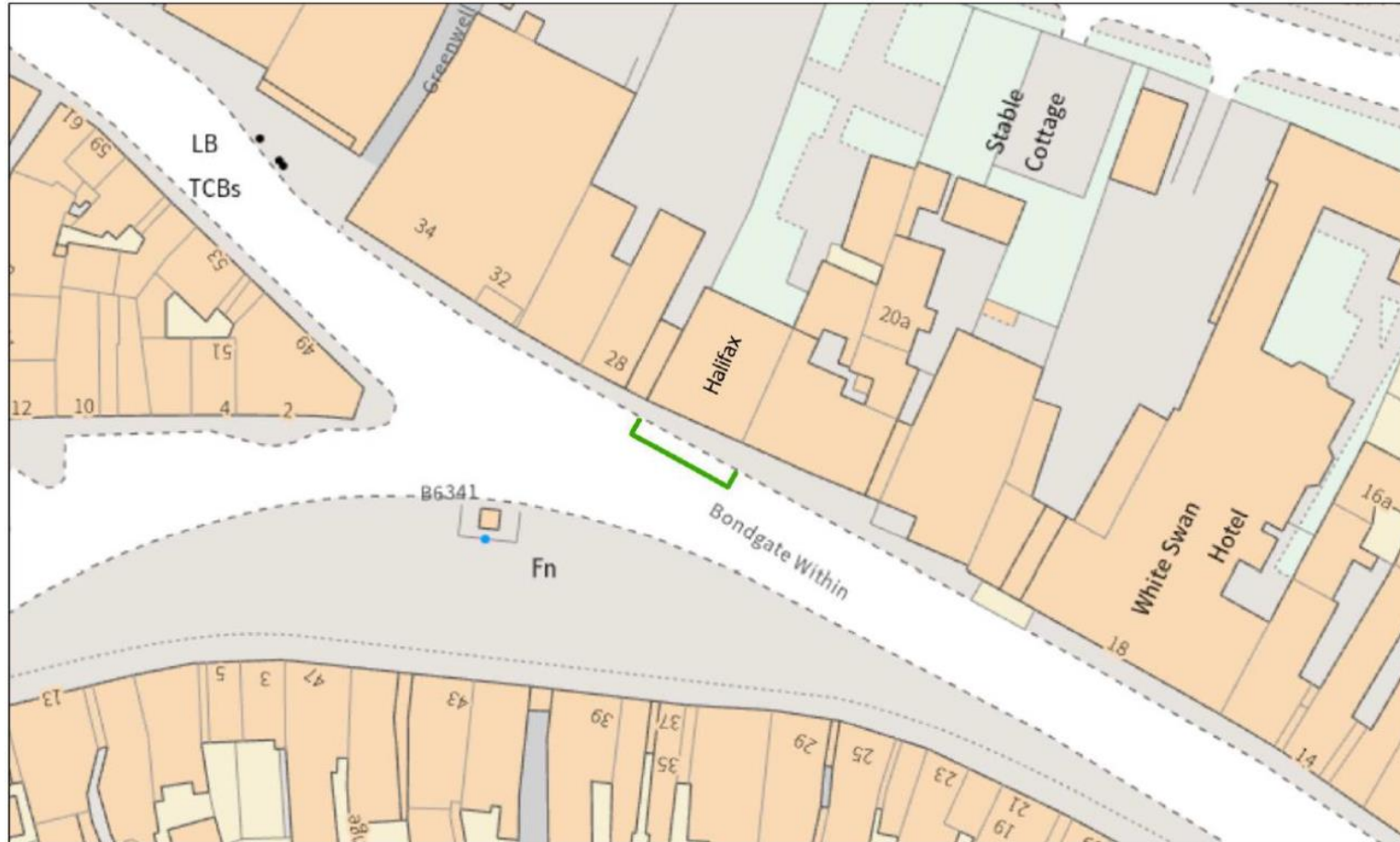

1		In my opinion there is no need for a taxi rank in Bondgate Within. Nobody uses the rank through the day and night time you can park anywhere on the main street. When we have bookings from public houses or hotels we arranged to pick them up outside their establishment. Customers do not want to walk in cold, damp, inclement weather to a taxi rank at night or through the day.
1		I fully support the removal of this facility. We have lived in Northumberland for over X years and despite visiting Alnwick several times a week have never seen a taxi on this rank.
1		No comments.
1		I think this is a very bad idea to have any taxi rank 'part-time' because it's difficult enough as it is to have a designated area where the public can wait or hire a taxi. The amount of disruption this causes through traffic abusing full time taxi ranks as car parks is already ridiculous! There is zero support as it is from local councils or the government regarding any enforcement of the public abusing taxi ranks as a car park. I personally feel it's a huge insult to the taxi trade this proposal! I would rather the Alnwick Taxi rank is full time, is located elsewhere full-time (near Alnwick bus station for example) or is just removed altogether by proposing a part-time taxi rank is in my eyes is a complete joke & just highlights the lack of understanding from the council for the importance of taxi ranks. I seriously hope this proposal is reconsidered. Above anything else having a part-time taxi rank is a serious safeguarding concern! Taxi ranks should always be full-time! Taxi drivers are required to jump through hoops to get licensed yet the national & local attitude from authorities towards taxi ranks is ridiculous, it's only a matter of time before someone with evil intentions see that any Tom, Dick or Harry can abuse taxi ranks anyway they like!
1		I am responding to the consultation regarding the proposed hybrid parking scheme in Bondgate Within Alnwick, that intends to remove taxi rank status form the parking bay where it is at present and restore it to 2 hour parking for all vehicles between 8am-pm. Whilst I support restoration of normal parking, I have yet to see a single taxi use the space in the evening and a taxi company owner I spoke to said it was completely unnecessary to retain it for taxi use at any time. Therefore, I recommend that the space is allocated to any vehicles for 24 hours every day.
1		Alnwick Town Council have reviewed the proposed amendments to the taxi rank in Bondgate Within Alnwick and would request that, as the taxi rank is not needed or used, it is removed.
