Proposed Parking Restrictions – Cambois First School, Cambois

Purpose of Report

This report sets out the background to the proposal to introduce new parking restrictions directly outside Cambois First School in Cambois.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the proposed parking restrictions are implemented in order to improve road safety in the area.

Key Issues

Delegated Decision

- 1. Northumberland County Council has received concerns from Cambois First School regarding indiscriminate parking directly outside the school entrance during school start and end times.
- 2. As a result, additional parking restrictions have been proposed directly outside the school to alleviate these concerns.
- 3. The scheme is supported by the local County Councillor, Cambois Parish Council and school representatives.
- 4. The scheme is to be funded through the 2024/25 Local Transport Plan (LTP) programme.

Background

Cambois First School is situated directly next to the C403 road which is the main access route through Cambois. The confined area of Selbourne Terrace is where vehicles currently park on the carriageway and footways causing obstructions during school pick up and drop off times, whilst a lot of traffic can also be observed in this small, congested area. Concerns have been raised by school representatives as a result of this.

Proposal

Representatives from Cambois First School informed NCC of how close vehicles park next to the school at pick up and drop off times and also raised concerns of vehicles parking on the junctions of Selbourne Terrace reducing visibility. In order to alleviate these issues, further parking restrictions are proposed.

'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions in the form of double yellow lines are proposed on each of the junctions of Selbourne Terrace and the existing School Keep Clear zig-zag road markings are also proposed to be extended across the school entrance.

The proposal is intended to increase road safety, maintain the free flow of traffic where possible and to protect the amenity of the area overall. Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of these amendments as part of the process for making the permanent Traffic Regulation Order.
