

Record of decision made under delegated powers in relation to a Traffic Regulation Order at South Road & The Peth, Wooler (TRO_101_01)

1 The decision taken:

In exercise of my delegated powers under the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 ("the Regulations"), I have taken the decision to make the above-mentioned Traffic Regulation Order ("TRO") without modification.

2 The reasons for making this decision:

- 2.1 Northumberland County Council ("the Council") has carried out a consultation on the making of the TRO and 14 objections were made.
- 2.2 The Council has duly and carefully considered all of the objections made. However, in order to ensure the free flow of traffic on an emergency services route and prohibit visitor-associated parking with the Ad Gefrin distillery site on the adjacent highway, the Council although acknowledging the number and nature of the objections has decided to make the TRO without modification.

To make the TRO without modification.
