PROPOSED WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS ON LANGLEY ROAD HAYDON BRIDGE

Purpose of report:

This Delegated Decision Report is for the proposed implementation of a traffic regulation order, which is being introduced on grounds of road safety. Because the TRO is being introduced on grounds of safety no public consultation has been carried out, however, the Parish Council Council and County Councilor Alan Sharp are in support.

Key Issues:

It has been brought to the attention of Council Officers, by the local County Councillor, that there are road safety issues adjacent to Shaftoe Trust First School in Haydon Bridge. These issues are as a result of parked cars adjacent to the school, at predominantly school opening/closing times. It is proposed to extend the existing keep clear road markings (yellow zigzag lines) and introduce No Waiting restrictions (double Yellow Lines) to help alleviate these issues. See attached - Appendix A.

A formal consultation did not take place. However, the statutory consultees were notified and no concerns were registered, also the Parish Council and County Councilor Alan Sharp have been consulted and are supportive. An update on the proposal was provided by NCC Officers to the Parish Council at their meeting of 26th October 2017.

The Traffic Regulation Order for these changes will be advertised by NCC Legal Section, once this Delegated Decision Report has been signed.
