Proposed No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions, Park View / B1329 Ridley Avenue, Blyth

8th August 2017

Purpose of Report

To consider the introduction of a "No Waiting At Any Time", restriction on the junction of Park View / B1329 Ridley Avenue, Blyth.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the following restrictions are introduced on Park View / Ridley Avenue, Blyth: No waiting at any time, (double yellow lines).

Key Issues

- 1. This area has been the subject of traffic safety concerns over a period of time i.e. obstruction of a junction, resulting in visibility issues, raising concerns with residents, local Councillor and Town Council.
- 2. The Scheme is funded and supported by County Councillor Eileen Cartie

Background

- 1. Safety concerns have been identified to Councillor Cartie by residents on a number of occasions with regard to obstruction of a junction.
- 2. It is proposed to introduce no waiting at any time restriction in this area.
- 3. This would help improve traffic safety for the residents and road users of Park View, Blyth.

Consultation

- 1. A formal consultation did not take place as this proposal is on traffic safety improvement grounds. The proposal will augment the Highway code, rule **243-5**: DO NOT stop or park opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space.
- 2. Support for the proposal is provided by both Councillor Cartie, residents of Park View and Blyth Town Council. (See appendix B).
- 3. Statutory consultees have been notified.
- 4. Advertising of the scheme will be carried out via the legal process for the introduction of a new Traffic Regulation Order.

Comments

1. This scheme will be carried out at the same time as a other similar schemes in the Wesleydale Ward, Blyth, which has also been proposed and agreed with Councillor Cartie. Thereby, making a saving in advertising costs for the traffic regulation order and programming.

Recommendations

- It is recommended to introduce a "No Waiting At Any Time", restriction on the junction of Park View / B1329 Ridley Avenue, Blyth. As detailed in Appendix A
- 2. The Council has the power to hold a public inquiry before making any traffic regulation order. Such an inquiry might enable disputed evidence to be tested under cross-examination and the need for an order to be critically examined by an independent inspector. In this particular case, officers believe that the consultation process and involvement with interested parties, means that such an inquiry is unlikely to bring any fresh information to light and it is therefore recommended that an inquiry is not held.


