RECORD OF DECISION TAKEN BY DIRECTOR OF LOCAL SERVICES AND HOUSING

INTRODUCTION OF 20MPH SPEED LIMIT - U7038 BETWEEN TWICE BREWED AND STEEL RIGG CAR PARK

Purpose of Report

To consider the introduction of a twelve month Experimental Traffic Regulation Order relating to a proposed 20mph speed limit on the U7038 from Twice Brewed to Steel Rigg Car Park, which is required in order to improve road safety for pedestrians and other road users around The Sill National Landscape Discovery Centre.

Recommendations

It is recommended that in order to improve road safety for pedestrians and other road users around The Sill, a 20mph Speed Limit should be introduced on the U7038 between Twice Brewed and Steel Rigg Car Park.

Link to Corporate Plan

This report is relevant to the 'Stronger Communities and Families' priority included in the NCC Corporate Plan 2013-2017.

Key Issues

- 1) Scheme to be funded by LTP
- 2) Scheme compliments additional road safety improvements in the area.
- Experimental Traffic Regulation Order is quicker to introduce given time restraints relating to the opening of The Sill National Landscape Discovery Centre. (due to open on Saturday 29th July).
- 4) Scheme supported by The Sill, Northumberland National Parks, Local County Councillor and Local Parish / Town Councils.
- 5) Reduced speed limit is required to protect walkers on the U7038 walking to and from The Sill from Steel Rigg Car Park.
- 6) Scheme will improve road safety in the area.
- 7) It is anticipated that the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order will be made permanent. However, comments are invited throughout the duration of the Experimental Order. Any comments should be sent to

Recommendations

1) It is recommended that a twelve month Experimental 20mph Speed Limit is introduced on the U7038 between Twice Brewed and Steel Rigg Car Park in order to improve road safety in the area, after which, a Permanent Traffic Order will be made.




