PROPOSED RESIDENTS PERMIT PARKING, NORTH END, LONGHOUGHTON Cabinet Member:

Purpose of Report

To consider the results of the consultation exercise, regarding a proposal to provide residents permit parking at North End, Longhoughton.

Recommendations

It is recommended that:

1) Residents permit parking should be provided in the layby outside numbers 29-43 North End, Longhoughton.

Link to Corporate Plan

This report is relevant to the *Places and Environment Aim* in the Corporate Plan:

"Our aim is to maintain and further improve the quality of our towns, villages and countryside and make it easier for residents to access services and high quality, affordable homes and to travel using different modes of transport. To achieve this, we will keep Northumberland clean, green and safe from detrimental impacts of climate change, build more houses to benefit those most in need and provide a convenient, integrated public transport network."

Key Issues

- 1. The County Council received a request from residents of numbers 29-43 North End, Longhoughton, via Councillor Kate Cairns, to provide residents only parking in the layby outside the bungalows.
- 2. Residents state that indiscriminate parking is preventing them from parking near their homes. Many of the residents are elderly.

Background

- 1. The County Council received a request from residents of numbers 29-43 North End, Longhoughton, via the former ward Councillor Kate Cairns, to provide residents only parking in the layby outside the bungalows.
- 2. Many of the residents of the bungalows are elderly and some are disabled.
- 3. Until recently there was a sign at the layby stating "Residents Only". The sign was put up by the former Alnwick District Council.
- 4. Since the sign was removed, residents of the bungalows have found it increasingly difficult to park outside their homes as other drivers have begun to park there.
- 5. A consultation was therefore carried out with residents and statutory consultees which resulted in 6 responses. 4 were in favour (67%), and 2 were neutral (33%). There were no responses against the proposal. A copy of the consultation plan is shown in Appendix A. The consultation results are shown in Appendix B.
- 6. Councillor Pattison is in favour of the proposal.
- 7. The Senior Civil Enforcement Officer suggested that parking bays are formally marked out in order to make best use of the space available.
- 8. It is therefore recommended that residents permit parking is provided and parking bays are formally marked out within the layby.
- 9. The scheme will be funded via the Traffic Management element of the Local Transport Plan Programme.


