Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 51 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 20-4 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 – Amendment No 21 Order 2014".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011".

"Amendment Order" means "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 – Amendment No 21 Order 2014".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

The following provisions shall be additions to, deletions from, or substitutions in the restrictions detailed in the Order:

PART I – PRELIMINARY Article 2. Interpretation Will be deleted and replaced with the following:

2. Interpretation

In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"The 2000 Regulations" means the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"The 2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"ambulance" has the same meaning as Schedule 2 of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;

"car club vehicle" a shared use vehicle available for hire by Car Club members and being used within an organised scheme operated by or on behalf of a contractor authorised by the Council"

"Council" means Northumberland County Council;

"civil enforcement officer" shall have the same meaning as in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 with the reference to "the authority" in subsection 2 thereof being a reference to the Council;

"conspicuous position" means, in relation to Articles 6 and 7 of this Order, that the ticket or permit shall be attached near to the windscreen or Driver's window of the motor vehicle in respect of which it was issued so that the validity of the ticket or permit is clearly visible from outside of the motor vehicle;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations;

"disabled person's parking place" means a parking place specified in Schedule 4

"disabled persons vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disc parking place" means a parking place specified in Schedule 11;

"disc parking zone" means an area referred to in Article 21(1) to this Order and any one zone may be referred to by the reference number given to that Zone in Article 21(1) to this Order.

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"electric vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009.

"emergency vehicle" means a vehicle as defined by regulation 3 of the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1989 (SI 1989/1796);

- "goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
- "goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description and is not drawing a trailer;
- "invalid carriage" has the same meanings as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;
- "Limited Waiting Parking Place" means a parking place specified in Schedule 2
- "maximum permitted stay" means the maximum time that a vehicle may be left in a parking place as defined in column 9 of Schedule 2, 3 or 11;
- "motorcycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;
- "owner" in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such a vehicle is kept and used;
- "parking bay" means a marked area in a parking place referred to in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 for the leaving of a vehicle;
- "parking device" has the same meanings as in Section 51 of the Act of 1984;
- "parking disc" means a device, issued by a local authority in England or Wales, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began;
- "parking dispensation" means a dispensation issued by the Council in accordance with Article 19:
- "parking place" means any area on a highway referred to in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11;
- "parking space" means a space individually marked for the leaving of a vehicle within a parking place referred in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 hereto;
- "pay and display parking place" means parking place specified in Schedule 3
- "passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motorcycle or invalid carriage) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than eight passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;
- "penalty charge" shall have the same meaning as in section 92 of the Traffic Management Act 2004
- "penalty charge notice" shall mean a notification issued by the Council under section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004
- "permit" means a residents permit or visitor's permit issued under the conditions of Article 11;
- "permit holder" means a residents permit holder or visitor's permit holder, to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of Article 11;
- "permit holder parking place" means a parking place specified in Schedules 1, 2 or 3;

- "permitted hours" in relation to a parking place, means the times of operation specified in Schedule 6 as represented by the corresponding time code in column 6 of Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 of this order relating to that parking place;
- "portfolio of plans" means the portfolio of plans attached to this Order
- "police vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the 2002 Regulations;
- "provision of a universal postal service", "universal service provider" and "postal packet" have the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000;
- "recharging post" means a device designed for the recharging of Electrical Vehicle."
- "relevant position" a) In the case of a disabled person's badge the position described in Regulation 4 of the 2000 Regulations;
- b) In the case of a parking disc a vehicle displays the disc relevant position if
- i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or a fascia panel the disc is exhibited so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
- ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle:
- "resident" means a person whose usual place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is in any street or part of a street in Northumberland;
- "resident's permit" means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;
- "road marking" has the same meaning as in Regulation 25 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;
- "street" includes any part of a street;
- **"telecommunication system"** has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- "ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine relating to a parking place referred to in Schedule 3;
- "ticket machine" means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, for the purposes of this Order being an apparatus designed to issue a ticket indicating the payment of the parking charge referred to in Article 13 and to indicate the time by which the parking period for which payment was made by the parking charge will expire;
- "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or as having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act of 1984;

"vehicle" has the same meaning as that assigned to "motor vehicle" in section 136(1) of the Act of 1984;

"visitor" means a person who is visiting a resident and who has obtained a visitors permit from and with the permission of that resident;

"visitor's permit" means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

"zone" means the parking zone within which a permit is valid.

PART II -PARKING PLACES

Will be deleted and replaced with the following: PART II -PARKING PLACES

4. Designation of parking places

Any length of road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 of this Order as a parking place is hereby designated as a parking place.

5. Use of a Parking Place

No person shall use a Parking Place other than as specified in this Order

6. Vehicles for which parking places are designated

Each parking place specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 of this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles as are Passenger Vehicles, Goods Vehicles, Motorcycles or Invalid Carriages provided that the use of that Parking Place or part of the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left has not been suspended.

Each parking place specified in in Column 8 of Schedule 8 of this Order may only be used for the leaving of police vehicles provided that the use of that Parking Place or part of the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left has not been suspended.

Each parking place specified in Column 8 of Schedule 9 of this Order may only be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of car club vehicles provided that the use of that Parking Place or part of the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left has not been suspended.

Each parking place specified in Column 8 of Schedule 10 of this Order may only be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted

hours of electric vehicles provided that the use of that Parking Place or part of the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left has not been suspended.

7. Tickets, permits and vouchers, to be displayed on vehicles left in certain parking places

(1) Residents' Parking Places

Save as provided in articles 17 & 19, at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a residents parking place as specified in Schedules 1, 2 or 3 during the Permitted Hours there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle:

- (i) a valid Residents Permit; or
- (ii) a valid Visitors Permit: or
- (iii) a valid Parking Dispensation.

displayed so that all the particulars of the Permit or Parking Dispensation are readily visible from the front or near side of the Vehicle.

(2) Limited Waiting Disc Zone Parking Places

Save as provided in article 17 & 19, at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a Limited Waiting Disc Zone Parking Places as specified in Schedules 11, during the Permitted Hours and for more than the Maximum Permitted Stay there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle:

- (i) a valid Disabled Person's Badge; or
- (ii) a valid Parking Dispensation.

displayed so that all the particulars of the Permit or Parking Dispensation are readily visible from the front or near side of the Vehicle.

(3) Limited Waiting Parking Places

Save as provided in article 17 & 19, at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a Limited Waiting Parking Place as specified in Schedule 2, during the Permitted Hours and for more than the Maximum Permitted Stay there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle:

- (iii) a valid Residents' Permit;
- (iv) a valid Visitor's Permit:
- (v) a valid Disabled Person's Badge; or
- (vi) a valid Parking Dispensation.

displayed so that all the particulars of the Permit or Parking Dispensation are readily visible from the front or near side of the Vehicle.

(4) Pay and Display Parking Places

Save as provided in Article 17 & 19 at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a Pay and Display Parking Place as specified in Schedule 3, during the Permitted Hours, there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle a valid Ticket.

Or for more than the Permitted Hours:

- (i) a valid Resident's Permit;
- (ii) a valid Visitor's Permit:
- (iii) a valid Disabled Person's Badge; or
- (iv) a valid Parking Dispensation

displayed so that all the particulars of the Permit or Parking Dispensation are readily visible from the front or near side of the Vehicle.

(5) Disabled Person's Parking Places

Save as provided in Articles 17 & 19 at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a Disabled Person's Parking Place, as specified in Schedule 4, there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle a valid Disabled Person's Badge so that all the particulars are readily visible from the front or nearside of that Vehicle.

PART III - SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

Will be deleted and replaced with the following: PART III – SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

Section 1 - Use of a Parking Place

8. Manner of standing and waiting in a parking place

Every Vehicle left in a Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall so stand:

- (i) in the case of a Parking Place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a Vehicle in that parking place are specified in column 7 of Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 as to be in accordance with those provisions;
- (ii) for a Parking Place specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 so that every part of the Vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay or parking space;

9. Restriction on the use of a parking place

No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.

Section 2 - Permits

10. Application for permits

(1) Residents' Parking Permits

Any Resident who is the Owner of a Vehicle of a class specified in Article 6 may apply to the Council for the issue of a Residents Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of that Vehicle in a Parking Place.

(2) Visitors' Parking Permits

Any Resident may apply to the Council for the issue of a Visitors Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified in Article 6 in a Residents Parking Place by a Visitor to premises occupied by such Resident.

(3) Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permits

Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified in Article 6 in an On Street Pay and Display Parking Place, during the permitted hours.

All applications made in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2) or (3) of this Article shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars information and evidence required by such form.

11. Issue of permits

- (1) On receipt of an application made for a Residents Parking Permit under the foregoing provisions of Article 10 and upon being satisfied that the applicant is a Resident, the Council may issue to the applicant a Parking Permit of the requisite type for that Zone.
- (2) The annual charge of a Permit is:
 - for a Residents Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
 - (ii) for a Visitors Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
 - (iii) for a Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order
- (3) The issue of any Permit shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.

12. Restriction on the removal of permits

Where a Permit has been displayed on a Vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of this Order no person not being the Driver of the Vehicle shall remove the Permit from the Vehicle unless authorised to do so by the Driver of the Vehicle.

Section 3 - Pay and Display Operation

13. Amount of parking charge, maximum stay and return time

- (1) The charge for a Vehicle left in a Parking Place specified in Schedule 3 to this Order shall be as defined for the corresponding tariff code as set out in Column 2 of Schedule 5 to this Order.
- (2) The maximum length of time for the purposes of paragraph (1) of this Article shall be the maximum duration of stay for the Parking Place specified in Column 9 of Schedule 3 of this Order.
- (3) When a Vehicle has left a Parking Place after waiting thereon, the Driver thereof shall not within such a time as is defined in Column 9 of Schedule 3 to this Order after its leaving permit the said Vehicle to wait again in the same Parking Place.

14. Payment of the Parking Charge

(1) The charge payable in Article 13(1) shall be payable on the leaving of the Vehicle in the Parking Place by the insertion in the Ticket Machine relating to

- that Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left of coins or other means of payment as the Ticket Machine may accept, to the requisite amount.
- (2) Upon payment of the charge for the Vehicle the Driver thereof shall exhibit on the Vehicle that Ticket so that the time shown on the front of the said Ticket is clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the Vehicle.

15. Indications by ticket machine tickets

- (1) Subject to Article 7(4), payment of the parking charge specified in Article 14(1) shall be indicated by the issue of a Ticket indicating the payment of that Parking Charge has been paid, and the day and time by which the parking period for which payment was made by the Parking Charge will expire, and by the display of that Ticket on the Vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 14(2).
- (2) Subject to Article 7(4), the expiry of the parking period for which the Parking Charge has been paid shall be indicated when there is displayed on the Vehicle a Ticket showing the day and time by which the parking period for which payment was made will expire, and the day so shown on the clock of the said Ticket Machine is later than the time shown on the ticket.
- (3) The Ticket referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be so exhibited on the Vehicle that the time shown on the front of the said Ticket is clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the Vehicle.
- (4) Payment of the Parking Charge for a Vehicle left in a Parking Place shall be indicated by the issue of a numbered Ticket indicating that the charge has been paid in respect of the day and expiry time of the period of parking and by exhibition of that Ticket on the Vehicle in the manner specified in paragraph (3) of this Article.
 - (a) If, at any time while a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place during the Permitted Hours, no Ticket is exhibited on that Vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the last preceding Article, it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved, that the charge has not been duly paid.
 - (b) If at any time while a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place during the Permitted Hours, the expiry of the period of parking shown on the Ticket is earlier than the time shown on the Ticket Machine, relating to the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left, it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved, that the charge has been duly paid and that the period for which payment was made by the charge has already expired.

16. Location

(1) Every Vehicle left in a Parking Place in respect of which a charge has been incurred, shall so stand that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a Parking Place, which shall be the appropriate place in relation to the Ticket Machine in which has been or should have been, inserted any coin or other

- means of payment as the Ticket Machine may accept for the purpose of payment of the charge.
- (2) Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of the last preceding Article of this Order, a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

17. Police

(1). Where a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened, or not complied with, in respect of a Vehicle left in a Parking Place, he may remove, or cause to be removed, the Vehicle from the Parking Place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the Vehicle.

Section 4 – Parking Dispensation

18. Application for a parking dispensation

- (1) A person who intends to use a Vehicle in connection with building, construction, demolition, repair or maintenance, other operations or works to premises or land adjacent to a Parking Place, or who is a professional health carer on duty at premises or land adjacent to a Parking Place or for any other purpose that may reasonably require the use of a Vehicle may apply to the Council for the issue of a Parking Dispensation which may be valid for use with a Vehicle.
- (2) Any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied.

19. Issue of a parking dispensation

- (1) Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of Article 18, and upon receipt of the charge specified in paragraph (2) of this Article, the Council upon being satisfied that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary for the Vehicle to wait in a Parking Place, may issue to the applicant a Parking Dispensation.
- (2) The holder of a Parking Dispensation may park only in those parking places and for such periods as specified on the Parking Specification.
- (3) The charge of a parking dispensation is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
- (4) The issue of any parking dispensation shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.

20. Restriction on the removal of a parking dispensation

No person other than the Driver of the vehicle shall remove the Parking Dispensation unless authorised to do so by the Driver of the Vehicle.

Section 5 – Disc Zone Parking Operation

21. Display of parking discs, maximum stay and return time

(1) Each of the lengths of road as specified in the following table are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a Disc Parking Zone. Any one zone may be referred to by the reference number given to that Zone in the following table.

- (2) Each of the lengths of Road or sides of Road as specified in Schedule 11 are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a Parking Place
- (3) The maximum length of time for the purposes of this Article shall be the maximum duration of stay for the Parking Place specified in Column 9 of Schedule 11 of this Order
- (4) When a Vehicle has left a Parking Place after waiting thereon, the Driver thereof shall not within such a time as is defined in Column 9 of Schedule11 to this Order after its leaving permit the said Vehicle to wait again in the same Parking Place.
- (5) Subject to the provisions of Articles 24, the Driver shall, on the arrival of the Motor Vehicle at any Parking Place specified in Schedule 11 during the Permitted Hours as specified in Column 9 of Schedule 11 exhibit on the Motor Vehicle in accordance with the following provisions of this Article a Parking Disc;

- (6) The Parking Disc shall be exhibited on the Motor Vehicle in the Relevant Position;
- (7) The Parking Disc, while exhibited on the Motor Vehicle, shall so be placed that the arrival time shown on the front of the Parking Disc is clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the Motor Vehicle;
- (8) The Driver of a Motor Vehicle shall, on exhibiting the Parking Disc on the Motor Vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the last preceding Article, set the Parking Disc so that it indicates the Quarter Hour Period during which the Motor Vehicle arrived at the Parking Place;
- (9) When a Parking Disc exhibited in pursuance of this Part of this Order is showing an exact quarter hour, then that time, or where the indicated time of arrival is not shown as an exact quarter hour, then the next Quarter Hour Period indicated on a Parking Disc, as the case may be, shall be treated as evidence that the Motor Vehicle has been waiting in that Parking Place since that time.
- (10) Where in any proceedings for a contravention under Articles 21 and 22, of this Order. If is not proved that the contravention has been committed, but it is proved that the Parking Disc had not been set in accordance with paragraph (8) of this Article the Owner shall be deemed to have contravened the provisions of Article 22 of this Order;

22. No person shall:

(1) set the Parking Disc otherwise than in accordance with Article 21 of this Order;

or

- (2) alter the Parking Disc (or the indications given therein) exhibited on a Motor Vehicle which has been set in accordance with Article 21 whilst the said Motor Vehicle remains in the Parking Place; or
- (3) exhibit on any Motor Vehicle any Parking Disc which has been otherwise altered, defaced, mutilated, or added to or upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible.

23. Location

Where any vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of this Order, a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

PART IV - EXCEPTIONS, AND SUSPENSIONS

Will be deleted and replaced with the following: PART IV – EXCEPTIONS, AND SUSPENSIONS

Section 1 – Exceptions and Exemptions

24. General Exceptions

- (1) Nothing in Articles 6, 7 or 8 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any Vehicle to stop or wait for so long as may be necessary:
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the Vehicle;
 - (b) to enable a Vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the Parking Place or length of road or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the Parking Place or length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) to enable a Vehicle not being a Passenger Vehicle to wait:
 - while Postal Packets addressed to premises adjacent to the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the Vehicle or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered; or
 - (ii) while Postal Packets are being collected for loading on the Vehicle from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place in which the Vehicle is waiting or, having been so collected, are being loaded thereon;
 - (d) to enable an Emergency Vehicle or a Vehicle to be used for, Local Authority or Water or Sewerage Undertaker purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - if a Vehicle is waiting owing to the Driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the control of the Driver or if such waiting as is necessary to prevent an accident;
 - (f) to enable a Vehicle to wait in the street for so long as may be necessary in the taking in of petrol, oil, water or air, if such taking in cannot be effective unless the Vehicle waits where it is waiting;
 - (g) where the driver is required by law to stop;

(h) for preventing obstruction of the road by Order made on the occasion of any public procession rejoicing or illumination or where the road is thronged or liable to be obstructed to close or partially close the Parking Place.

25. Parking charge exemptions

No charge shall be payable and nothing in Article 13 or 14 of this Order shall apply:

- (1) in respect of any Vehicle left in a Parking Place during the charging hours as specified in Schedule 3, if that Vehicle is a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge:
- (2) If at the time when a Vehicle is left during the Permitted Hours in a Parking Place, there is on the Ticket Machine relating to that Parking Place, or in or adjacent to that Parking Place, a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council, or a civil enforcement officer, indicating that the Ticket Machine relating to that Parking Place is out of order, that Vehicle shall be exempt from the charge provided that it is removed within two hours after the said Ticket Machine is rectified; if the Vehicle is not removed within that period, the charge shall be treated as having been incurred and paid at the time when the Vehicle was left in the Parking Place and all the provisions of Article 15 of this Order shall apply accordingly.
- (3) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provision of this Article nothing in this Article shall be taken to exempt the Vehicle or the Driver of any Vehicle left in any Parking Place from any other provisions of this Order.

26. Disabled blue badge exemptions

Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall prohibit any Vehicle from stopping for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same Vehicle in the same road or part of road on the same day) if the vehicle is a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge issued in accordance with the provisions of the 2000 Regulations or a badge having effect under those regulations as if it were a Disabled Person's Badge and a parking disc as defined in Regulation 8(5) of the 2000 Regulations and the Driver or other person in charge of the Vehicle marks on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting began.

Section 2 – Suspensions

27. Power to suspend the use of a parking place

- (1) The Council may by display of a notice on or near the Parking Place suspend the parking restriction or the use of a Parking Place, or any part thereof, whenever it considers such suspension reasonably necessary:
 - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;

- (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Parking Place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the Parking Place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line, traffic sign or ticket machine;
- (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction, that any road will be thronged or obstructed; or
- (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (2) A police constable in uniform may suspend, for not longer than twenty-four hours, the use of a Parking Place, or any part thereof, whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.

PART V - OPERATION

28. Contravention of restrictions and parking places

Save as provided in Articles 24, 25 and 26 of this Order, if a vehicle is left in a length of road defined in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 or 11 during the Permitted Hours without complying with the provisions of this Order a contravention shall be deemed to have occurred and a penalty charge notice may then be issued by a police constable in uniform or Civil Parking Enforcement Officer. Once issued a penalty charge shall be payable.

29. Revocation


