NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") have made the above named Orders under Sections 1 (1)(a),(c) and 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act").

The effect of the Orders, which will come into operation on 1st December 2015 until 30th November 2016, will be to amend various existing parking restrictions in Middle Greens area of Morpeth by amending North Northumberland (Southern) Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 (TRO_009) and the North Northumberland (Southern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 (TRO_010) on an experimental basis.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders you may within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose

If the provisions of the Experimental Orders continue in operation for a period of not less than 12 months, the Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely. Within the period of 6 months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, from the coming into force of that variation or modification (whichever is the latest), any person may object to the making of the Orders to continue indefinitely by sending a statement in writing of their objection or representation and the grounds thereof to the undersigned, at the address shown below.

Northumberland County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1)(a),(c) and 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

PART 1 PRELIMINARY

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on 1st December 2015, until 30th November 2016 and may be cited as the "The County of Northumberland North Northumberland (Southern) Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 - Amendment No 17 Experimental Order 2015 (TRO_009_17)".

2. Interpretation

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Council" means Northumberland County Council

"The Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

"The Principal Order" means North Northumberland (Southern) Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 (TRO_009)

3. General

- (1) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- (2) Where an Act of Parliament referred to in this Order or any Regulation, Direction or Order made under it is repealed and new provisions enacted (with or without modifications) new provisions shall be substituted in this Order where relevant.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament

PART 2 ADDITIONS & SUSPENSIONS OF WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS

1. Additions

- (1) There shall be added to Schedule 1 of the Principal Order the waiting restrictions specified in the First Schedule of this Experimental Order.
- (2) There shall be added to Schedule 4 of the Principal Order the keep clear restrictions specified in the First Schedule of this Experimental Order.
- (3) There shall be added to Schedule 6 of the Principal Order the times restrictions specified in the First Schedule of this Experimental Order

2. Deletions

(1) There shall be deletions to Schedule 1 of the Principal Order the waiting restrictions specified in the First Schedule of this Experimental Order.

3. Suspensions

None

PART 3 SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

The operation of this Experimental Order or any provision of it may be modified or suspended by the Council's Executive Director of Local Services if it appears to him essential -

- in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic;
- (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the order runs.

but this power shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate chief officer of police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct

STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The general effect of this Experimental Order will be to will be to introduce Resident Parking Zone in an area of Middle Greens, Morpeth. Together with associated minor changes to No Waiting at Any Time restrictions and an additional No Stopping restriction adjacent to the school on Goose Hill, of Middle Greens. Morpeth on an experimental basis

The reasons for introducing this by way of an Experimental Order are to assess the impact on parking and traffic flows with the introduction of a Resident Parking Zone in the Middle Greens area of Morpeth i.e. potential displacement of parking, use of existing car parks and so on.

Consideration will be given after a trial period as to whether or not the provisions of this Experimental Order should be made permanent. Currently, at the end of the trial period, the Council intends to consider making an order which will continue in force indefinitely having the same effect as the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.

The effects of this Order will be reviewed after 6 months
