Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 29th April 2013 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council (Off Street Parking Places) Composite Order 2010 - Amendment No 1 Order 2013".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council (Off Street Parking Places) Composite Order 2010".

"Amendment Order" means "Northumberland County Council (Off Street Parking Places) Composite Order 2010 - Amendment No 1 Order 2013".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

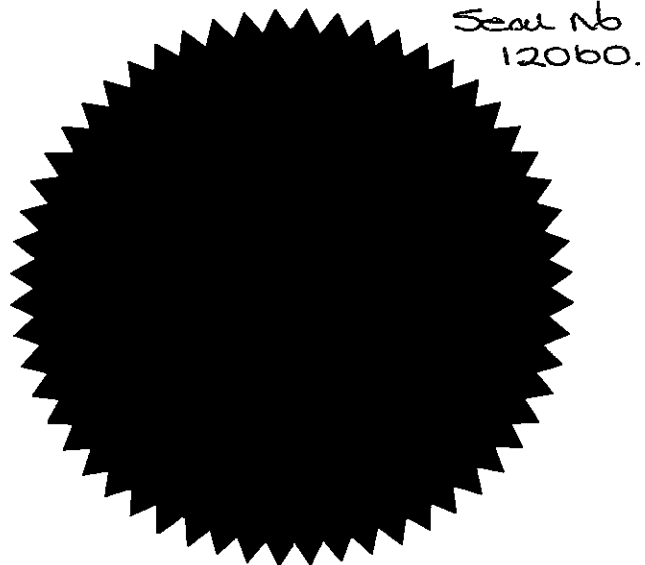
