ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (ACOMB VILLAGE 20MPH, 30MPH and 40MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2016 (TROM_017)

The Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 82(2), 83(2) and 84 (1) and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following order:

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on the 28th December 2016 and may be cited as "The County of Northumberland (Acomb Village 20MPH 30MPH and 40MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2016."
 - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
 - (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- Save as provided in Article 3, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 20mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 1, 30mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 2, and 40mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 3.
- Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in that Article if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
