One Way System Order 2016

Made: 25th May 2016

Coming into Force: 16th June 2016

Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), and 2 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 16th June 2016 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council - Amble Town Centre One Way System Order 2016".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council Amble Town Centre One Way System Order 2016"

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on the 16th June 2016 will be to introduce a One Way System in Amble Town Centre which will restrict traffic on the following lengths of roads:-

Easterly direction only

- U3138 Queen Street, Amble – From its junction with Bridge Street / Turner Street
- U3138 Coquet Street, Amble
- U3138 Leazes Street, Amble

South-easterly direction only

- U3138 Lawson Street, Amble

South-westerly direction only

- U3138 George Street, Amble

4. Exemptions

The National Cycle Route will remain unaffected by the introduction of the One Way System.

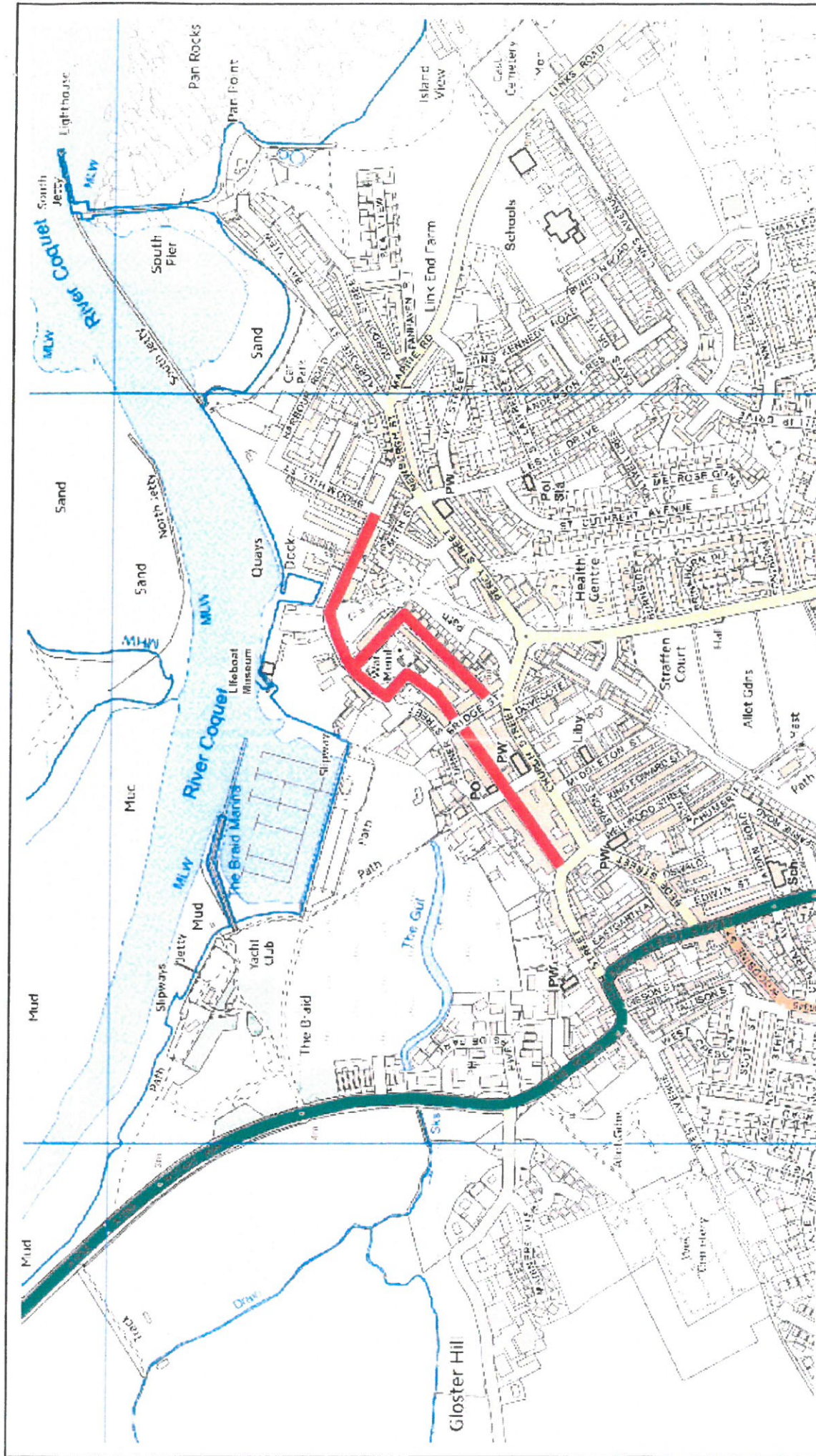
All emergency vehicles will be exempt from the One Way System.

Any vehicles travelling to Amble Harbour which are too large to negotiate the One Way System will be exempt, however the police should be given prior warning
