ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (MILE ROAD AND SURROUNDING AREA WIDDRINGTON STATION 20 MPH and 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2016 (TROM 049)

The Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 82(2), 83(2) and 84 (1) and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th December 2016 and may be (1) cited as "The County of Northumberland (Mile Road, Widdrington Station and Surrounding Area 20 MPH and 30MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2016."
 - The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in (2)derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
 - Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered (3)article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order
- Save as provided in Article 3, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to 2. cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 20 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 1 attached to this Order and 30 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 2 attached to this Order.
- Nothing in Article 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the 3. stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 attached to this Order and Schedule 2 attached to this Order if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
