TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Northumberland County Council
(Amble Town Centre One Way System) Order 2018

Made: 30th April 2018

Coming into Force: 14th May 2018

Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 14th May 2018 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council (Amble Town Centre One Way System) Order 2018".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council (Amble Town Centre One Way System) Order 2018".

"Specified" means specified in the Schedule to this Order

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on the 14th May 2018 will be to introduce a One Way System in Amble Town Centre which will restrict traffic on the following lengths of roads:-

Easterly direction only

- U3138 Queen Street, Amble
- U3138 Coquet Street, Amble
- U3138 Leazes Street, Amble

South-easterly direction only

- U3138 Lawson Street, Amble

South-westerly direction only

- U3138 George Street, Amble

4. Exemptions

All emergency vehicles will be exempt from the One Way System.

Any vehicles travelling to Amble Harbour which are too large to negotiate the One Way System will be exempt, however the police should be given prior warning.

5. Revocations

The effect of this order will further revoke the "Northumberland County Council Amble Town Centre One Way System Order 2016" and the "County of Northumberland (Queen Street, Amble) (No Waiting at Any Time, Limited Waiting, Loading Only, One Way Traffic and Revocation) Order 1996".
