**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(WEST WOODBURN 20 MPH, 30 MPH & 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTIONS)
ORDER 2018
(TROM_128)**

The Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84 (1) and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following order:

1. (1) This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd December 2018 and may be cited as "The County Council of Northumberland (West Woodburn 20 mph, 30 mph and 40 mph Speed Restrictions) Order 2018."

 (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

 (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
2. Save as provided in Article 5 and 6, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 20 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 1.
3. Save as provided in Article 5 and 6, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 30 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 2.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 and 6, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 40 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 3.
5. Nothing in Articles 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in that Article if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
6. Nothing in Articles 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in that Article if the vehicle is used by a member of the special forces and is being driven in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds or for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.



**STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR
PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER**

The Order is necessary as part of Northumberland County Council's road safety improvements adjacent to schools, by introducing a 20 MPH limit at West Woodburn First School and surrounding area. Together with amendments to the 30 and 40 mph speed limits, to create a 'buffer zone' between the national speed limit and the new 20 MPH speed limit.
