Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 24th October 2018 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council (Beatrice Avenue Blyth One Way Traffic Restriction) Order 2018".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council (Beatrice Avenue Blyth One Way Traffic Restriction) Order 2018".

"Specified" means specified in the Schedule to this Order

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on the 24th October 2018 will be to introduce a One Way System in Blyth which will restrict traffic movement on Beatrice Avenue Blyth as stated in Schedule 1 annexed to this Order.

4. Exemptions

All emergency vehicles will be exempt from the One Way System.

5. Revocations

None
