### NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (SEGHILL FIRST SCHOOL 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2020 (TROM\_166)

Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following order:

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 and may be cited as Northumberland County Council (Seghill First School 20 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2020."
  - (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 20 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 1.
- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in that Schedule if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
- 4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in that Schedule if the vehicle is used by a member of the special forces and is being driven in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds or for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
