NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SEATON SLUICE FIRST SCHOOL 20MPH SPEED RESTRICTION ORDER 2020 (TROM _167)

Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 81 to 84 and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following order:

- This Order shall come into operation on the 17th February 2020 and may be cited as Northumberland County Council Seaton Sluice First School 20mph Speed Restriction Order 2020.
 - (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 20mph on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 1.
- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
- 4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of the stated speed limit on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 if the vehicle is used by a member of the special forces and is being driven in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds or for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
