(One Way Restriction) Order 2020

Made: 12 February 2020

Coming into Force: 24th February 2020

Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") as amended and with all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 24th February 2020 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council Bowman Square/Ford Avenue Ashington (One Way Traffic Restriction) Order 2020".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council Bowman Square/Ford Avenue Ashington (One Way Traffic Restriction) Order 2020".

"Specified" means specified in the Schedule to this Order

"2001 Order" means "The County of Northumberland (Haydon Ward, Ashington) (No Entry) Order 2001".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in any specified road or in any specified length of road in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road as shown in the Schedule attached to this Order.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue and ambulance purposes.

5. Revocations

This Order will revoke section 2(b) of the 2001 Order, which reads as follows:

PART II


NO ENTRY

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the following lengths of highway:

(b) Ford Avenue, Ashington at its junction with Bywell Road travelling in a north easterly direction

The 2001 Order came into force on the 15th January 2001 and all other articles in the 2001 Order remain unchanged.

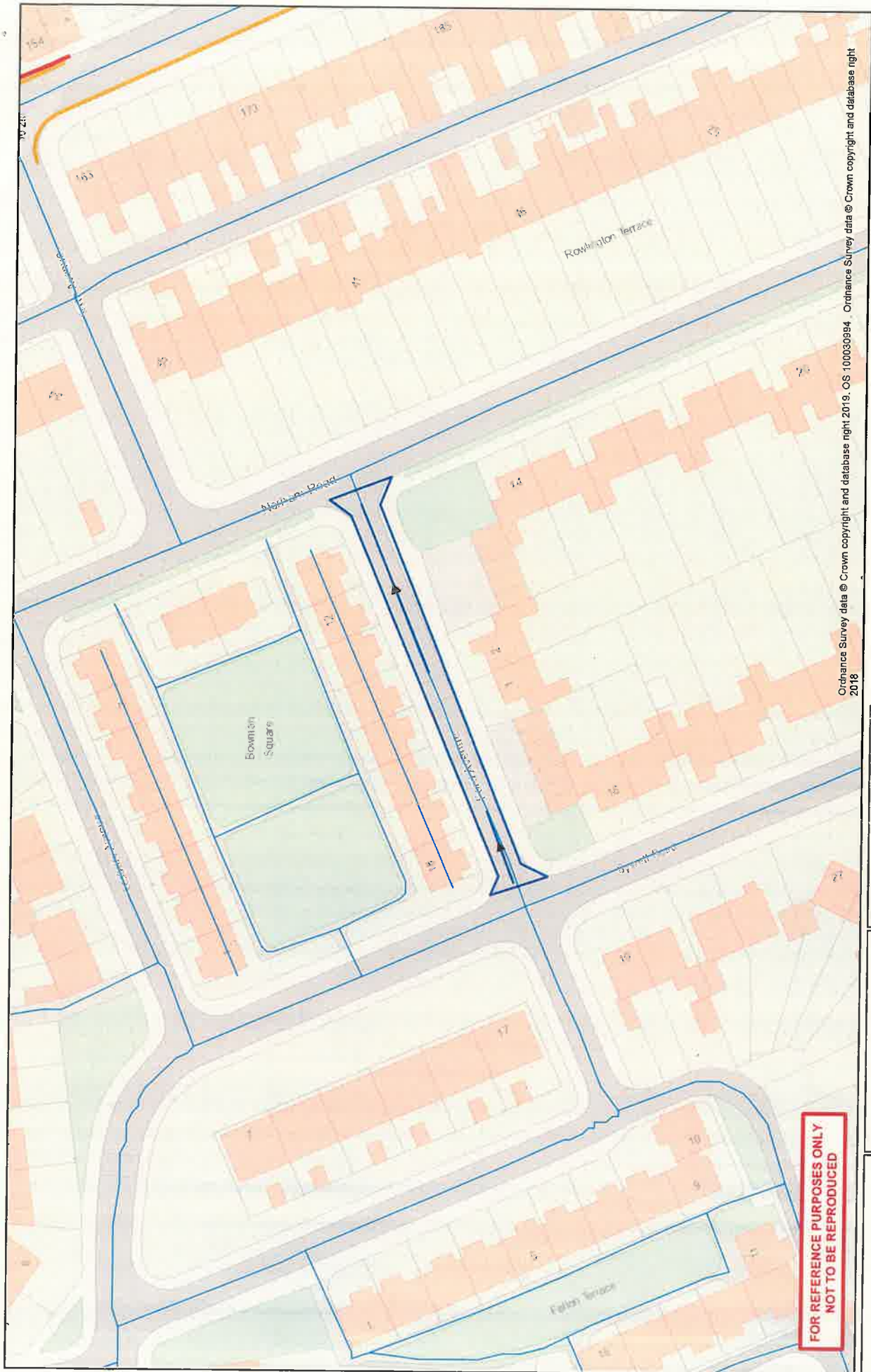
