

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(B6303 STATION ROAD ALLENDALE 30 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)
ORDER 2023 (TROM_249)**

Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. (1) This Order shall come into operation on the 6th November 2023 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council (B6303 Station Road Allendale 30 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2023."

 (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

 (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 mph on those lengths of highways detailed in The Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of 30 mph on those lengths of highways specified in The Schedule to this Order, if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of 30 mph on those lengths of highways specified in The Schedule to this Order, if the vehicle is used by a member of the special forces and is being driven in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds or for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
5. "The County of Northumberland (Station Road, Allendale B6303) (40 m.p.h Speed Restriction) Order 1985" is hereby revoked in full.

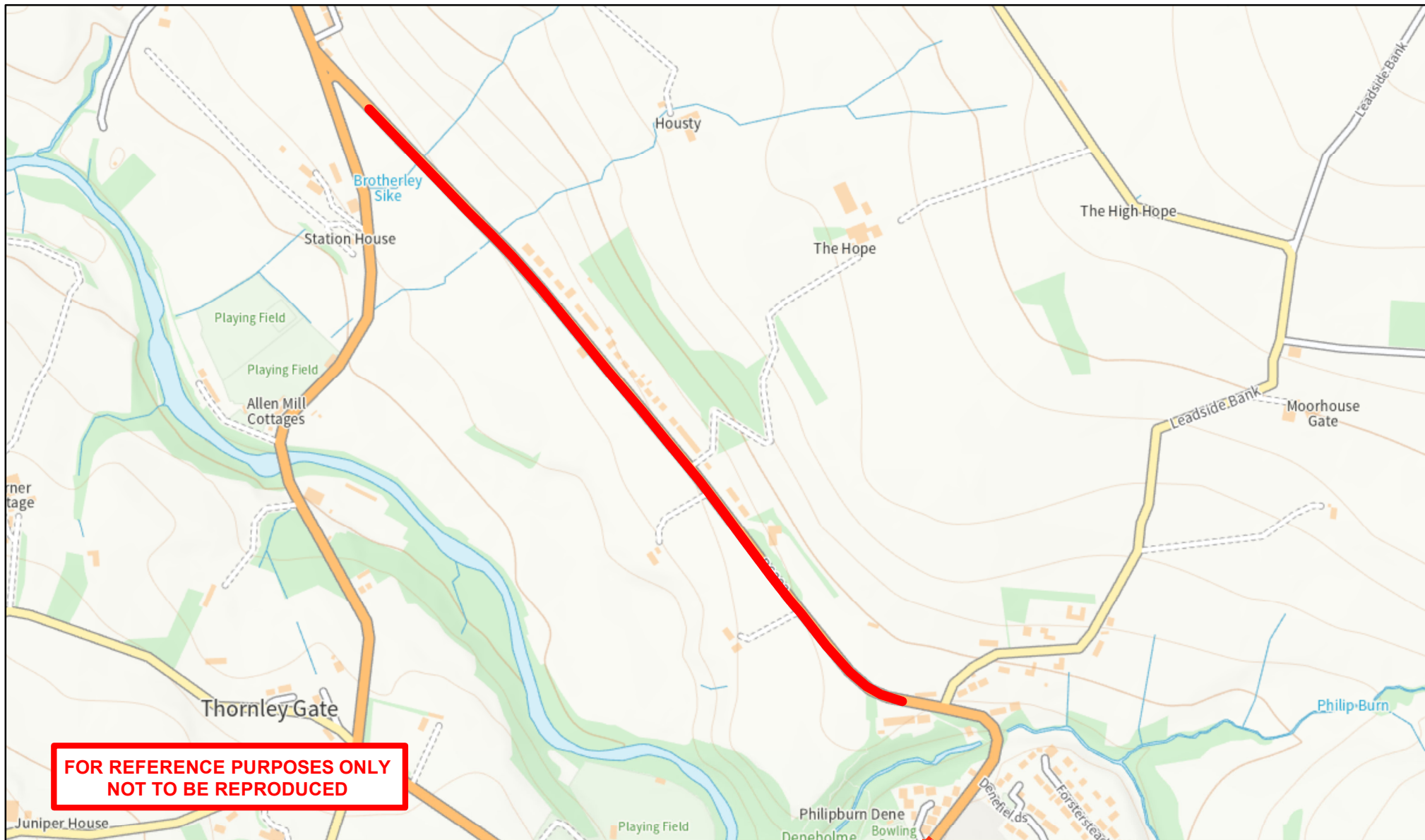
**30 MPH speed restriction on the following lengths of highways

41321142	B6303 STATION ROAD TO CATTON	ALLENDALE	At a point 110 metres south east of its junction with B6295 Catton Main Street to its junction with Station Road
41303493	STATION ROAD	ALLENDALE	For its entire length
41321058	B6303 ALLENDALE MAIN ROAD	ALLENDALE	At its junction with Station Road to a point 228 metres south east of its junction with Leadside Bank
