NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (CROSS STREET AMBLE ONE WAY & NO ENTRY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION) ORDER 2023 (TROM_284)

Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on the 5th June 2023 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council (Cross Street Amble One Way & No Entry Traffic Restriction) Order 2023."
 - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
 - (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
 - (4) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than bicycles to proceed in any specified length of road in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road as shown in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than bicycles to enter those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on those lengths of highway detailed in Schedule 1 and 2 of this Order, if the vehicle is being used for fire and rescue, police, ambulance or special forces purposes.
