(HAZELMERE ESTATE BEDLINGTON 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)
ORDER 2025 (TROM_322)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, which will come into force on the 3rd February 2025 will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of roads in Bedlington in the County of Northumberland:-

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
