Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on the 27th January 2025 and may be cited as Northumberland County Council (Rear Lintonville Terrace & Woodhorn Road Ashington Prohibition of Driving/Pedestrianisation, One-Way & No Entry Restrictions) Order 2025.
 - (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the length of road detailed in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 5, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on any specified lengths of roads in a direction other than that specified in relation to those lengths of roads detailed in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 5, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter the length of road detailed in Schedule 3 of this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on those lengths of roads detailed in Schedule 2 and 3, if the vehicle is being used for fire and rescue, police, ambulance or special forces purposes.


