**OFF STREET PARKING PLACES**  
**COMPOSITE ORDER 2014 AMENDMENT NO 24 ORDER 2025**

(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES – Ref: TRO\_019\_26):- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council have made the above-named Order under Sections 32 and 35 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

The effect of the Order, which will come into force on the 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025 will be to introduce new off-street car parking restrictions in Newbiggin-by-the-Sea in the County of Northumberland by amending the Northumberland County Council Off Street Parking Places Composite Order 2014 (the Principal Order).

The following restriction is added to the Principal Order:

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
