

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL  
(WAITING, LOADING & PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED)  
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2024 VARIATION ORDER 05  
(TRO\_101\_05)**

Notice is hereby given that Northumberland County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred under sections 1 to 4, 32, 35, 45 and 46, 61 and 64 (as appropriate) and Part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other powers so enabling, have made the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, which will come into force on the 27<sup>th</sup> May 2025 will be to vary the “Northumberland County Council (Waiting, Loading & Parking Places) (Map Based) Consolidation Order 2024” by introducing the following parking restrictions in that there will be ‘no waiting at any time’ on sections of the following roads:

- Eighth Avenue, Milburn Road and Lennep Way in Ashington.
- Choppington Road, Rothesay Terrace, Rothesay Terrace Back, Victoria Terrace, Victoria Terrace Back Lane, Victoria Terrace Back Lane Access Road, Road to Holmside and Station Road in Bedlington.
- Newsham Road, Malvins Road, Kings Gardens and Princes Gardens in Blyth.

There will also be an extension to the current “no waiting at any time” restriction on Unity Terrace in Cambois.

The restrictions can also be viewed in map format, as the maps form part of the map-based schedule to the Order. A copy of the Order, together with the maps that form part of the Schedule to the Order and any other relevant documents, notices or Orders as appropriate as well as a Statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order are available to view or download on the NCC Website:

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
