B1505 Klondyke, B1505 Valley Park to Klondyke, Cateran Way, East Farm Terrace, Hauxley Drive, U9550 Blagdon Terrace to Hillcrest School, Wasdale Close, Whitburn Place, Wilton Close and Windburgh Drive.
