(A697 LONGHORSLEY 30 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION EXTENSION) ORDER 2020
(TROM_173)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highway in the:- North of Longhorsley Village on the A697.

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.
