(TROM\_171)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highway in Barrasford Village:-

And will further introduce 30 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highway in Barrasford Village:-

41321925	C216 BARRASFORD TO BARRASFORD QUARRY	BARRASFORD	A point 282 metres north of its junction with Station Road (Grid Ref:391408 573539) to a point 580 metres south of its junction with Station Road (Grid Ref: 392164 573212)

This Order will hereby revoke all previous Orders or sections of Orders detailing speed limits, specified on the streets as detailed in Schedules 1 and 2 of this Order.

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.
