

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(B6395 COTTIER GRANGE PRUDHOE 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2021
(TROM_203)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a new 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highway, at the east end of the B6395 Prudhoe Town.
