**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northumberland County Council intend to make the above-named Order under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to prohibit any vehicle to enter the following road, unless required for access, on the following length of highway near Belsay in the County of Northumberland:
