

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(C70 ELLINGHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2021
(TROM_229)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intend to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the following length of road on the C70 adjacent to Ellingham Primary School in the County of Northumberland:-

USRN	Street	Town	Description
2518610	C70 TYNELY JUNCTION TO PRESTON JUNCTION	PRESTON	A point 38 metres east of its junction with U2030 (grid ref: 417488 625228) to a point 490 metres east of its junction with U2030 (grid ref: 417896 625343)

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.
