

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(ELLINGHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)
ORDER 2022 (TROM_251)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intend to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of road near Ellingham Primary School in the County of Northumberland:

This Order will hereby revoke the "Northumberland County Council (C70 Ellingham Primary School 40 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2021" in its entirety.

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.
