(TROM\_256)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highway in Morpeth in the County of Northumberland:-
