

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
(SOUTHFIELD GARDENS CRAMLINGTON 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)  
ORDER 2024 (TROM\_312)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highways in Cramlington in the County of Northumberland:-
