

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(B1340 BEADNELL 30 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)
ORDER 2024 (TROM_314)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highways in the County of Northumberland:-

2518842	C69 CHATHILL TO SWINHOE	SWINHOE	At a point 565 metres south west of its junction with the B1340 District Boundary To King Street road to its junction with the B1340 District Boundary To King Street road	420733, 628350 to 421226, 628484
2518535	B1340 DISTRICT BOUNDARY TO KING STREET	BEADNELL	At its junction with the C69 Chathill To Swinhoe road to a point 282 metres north east of its junction with the C69 Chathill To Swinhoe road	421226, 628484 to 421457, 628558

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.

This Order will hereby revoke all previous Orders or sections of Orders detailing speed limits on the lengths of highways specified in The Schedule of this Order.
