COMPOSITE ORDER 2011 AMENDMENT NO 105 ORDER 2021

(WAITING AND LOADING – Ref TRO 011-105) :- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council propose to make the above-named Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, and paragraphs 20 and 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce additional No Waiting At Any Time parking restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) on Park View and Park Villas in Ashington.

The following restrictions are added to the Principal Order, South East Northumberland Area (Waiting & Loading) Composite Order 2011

Addition – Waiting – Proscribed – At Any Time
