AMENDMENT NO 32 ORDER 2020**

(WAITING AND LOADING – Ref TRO_012_32):- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council propose to make the above-named Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order to provide Resident Permit Parking with Time Limited Waiting Parking Bays on Laburnum Terrace, Ashington and minor amendments to Resident Parking in Popular Street and Laburnum Terrace Myrtle Street Back Lane Ashington.

The following restrictions are added to the Principal Order, South East Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011

Every day 930am - 3pm & 330pm - 830am, Resident Permit Holders only**
