

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL  
SOUTH EAST AREA (PARKING PLACES) COMPOSITE ORDER 2011  
AMENDMENT NO 38 ORDER 2021**

(PARKING PLACES – Ref TRO\_012\_38):- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council propose to make the above-named Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a permanent Traffic Regulation Order to provide Disabled Blue Badge Holder Parking Places and Limited Waiting Parking Places in Cramlington following an Experimental Order.

The following restrictions are added to the Principal Order, South East Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011

**Addition - Schedule 2 – Limited Waiting Parking Places**

**Permitted Hours – Monday - Saturday 8am - 5pm 3 hours, No return within 4 hours**

**Addition - Schedule 2 – Limited Waiting Parking Places**

**Permitted Hours – Monday - Friday 8am - 5pm 20 mins, No return within 1 hour**

8075	SCHOOL ACCESS ROAD	CRAMLINGTON	North	At a point 70 metres west of its junction with Dudley Lane to a point 138 metres west of its junction with Dudley Lane

**Addition - Schedule 4 – Disabled Blue Badge Holders Parking Places**

**Permitted Hours – At Any Time**

**Addition - Schedule 6 – Times**

7.2	Monday - Saturday 8am - 5pm 3 hours, No return within 4 hours	G3

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.
