

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL  
(WAITING, LOADING & PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED)  
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2024 VARIATION ORDER 08  
(TRO\_101\_08)**

Notice is hereby given that Northumberland County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred under sections 1 to 4, 32, 35, 45 and 46, 61 and 64 (as appropriate) and Part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other powers so enabling, intends to make the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to vary the “Northumberland County Council (Waiting, Loading & Parking Places) (Map Based) Consolidation Order 2024” by introducing the following parking restrictions:

- No Waiting at Any Time on sections of Bristol Street, Melton Drive, St Michael's Avenue and U9536 Bristol Walk Hartley Court.
- No Waiting or Loading at Any Time on Double Row and Melton Drive.
- A prohibition of stopping on school entrance markings applying Monday-Friday between the hours of 8am-5pm on Melton Drive.

In addition, the ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ parking restrictions on Double Row in New Hartley will be removed.

The restrictions can also be viewed in map format, as the maps form part of the map-based schedule to the Order. A copy of the draft Order, together with the maps that form part of the Schedule to the Order and any other relevant documents, notices or Orders as appropriate as well as a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available to view or download on the NCC Website:
