

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**(WAITING, LOADING & PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED)**  
**CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2024 VARIATION ORDER 12**  
**(TRO\_101\_12)**

Notice is hereby given that Northumberland County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred under sections 1 to 4, 32, 35, 45 and 46, 61 and 64 (as appropriate) and Part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other powers so enabling, intends to make the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to vary the “Northumberland County Council (Waiting, Loading & Parking Places) (Map Based) Consolidation Order 2024” by introducing the following parking restrictions in Blyth:

- 1) There will be no waiting at any time on Bishopton Street, Kingsway and William Street.
- 2) There will be no waiting Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:30-9:30am & 2:30-4pm on Bishopton Street.
- 3) There will be an extension to the prohibition of stopping on school entrance markings applying Monday-Friday between the hours of 8am-5pm on Bishopton Street.

The restrictions can also be viewed in map format, as the maps form part of the map-based schedule to the Order. A copy of the draft Order, together with the maps that form part of the Schedule to the Order and any other relevant documents, notices or Orders as appropriate as well as a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available to view or download on the NCC Website:
