(TROM_179)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council intends to make the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed restriction on the following lengths of highway in the Tweedmouth West First School area of Tweedmouth:-

2504383	Osborne Place	Tweedmouth	for its entire length
2500196	Ladywell Road	Tweedmouth	for its entire length
2500196	Ladywell Place	Tweedmouth	for its entire length
2518510	U110 Osborne Road Back Lane	Tweedmouth	for its entire length

Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.
