WEST NORTHUMBERLAND AREA (WAITING AND LOADING)
COMPOSITE ORDER 2011 AMENDMENT NO 69 ORDER 2020**

(WAITING AND LOADING – Ref TRO 007-69):- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council propose to make the above-named Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, and paragraphs 20 and 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to delete a section of 'No Waiting At Any Time' parking restrictions (double yellow lines) on Whetstone Bridge Road, Hexham. Thereby, extending the bus standing area with the aim of reducing indiscriminate and improving road safety within the area.

The following restrictions are added to the Principal Order, West Northumberland Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011:-

Deletion – Waiting – Proscribed – At Any Time
