You understand that you are joining the event freely and hold your own liability for your Health and Safety during the activity. The activity lead will give instructions on the use of any equipment loaned and health and safety instructions.

By taking part and signing this form you agree to use this equipment and carry out the activity only in the manner for which it is intended. You MUST be physically fit to carry out this activity.

I declare that I am fit to carry out litter picking activities as part of this community event. I understand I am carrying out the activity at my own risk and Northumberland County Council are not liable for any injury to myself or others.

Activities must only be carried out in areas where it is safe to do so. For example, not on roads where there is no obvious pathway and on no roads faster than 30mph. If any 'dangerous' areas need to be cleared of rubbish this should be reported back to the Council. Large pieces of rubbish and hazardous materials should also be reported, the Council will arrange for its safe removal.

I will update my information with NCC if there are any changes or I wish to end my activity. I give my consent under the Data Protection Act 2018 (GDPR) for Northumberland County Council to retain and make reasonable use of the information I have provided in connection with its policies, procedures and practices.
